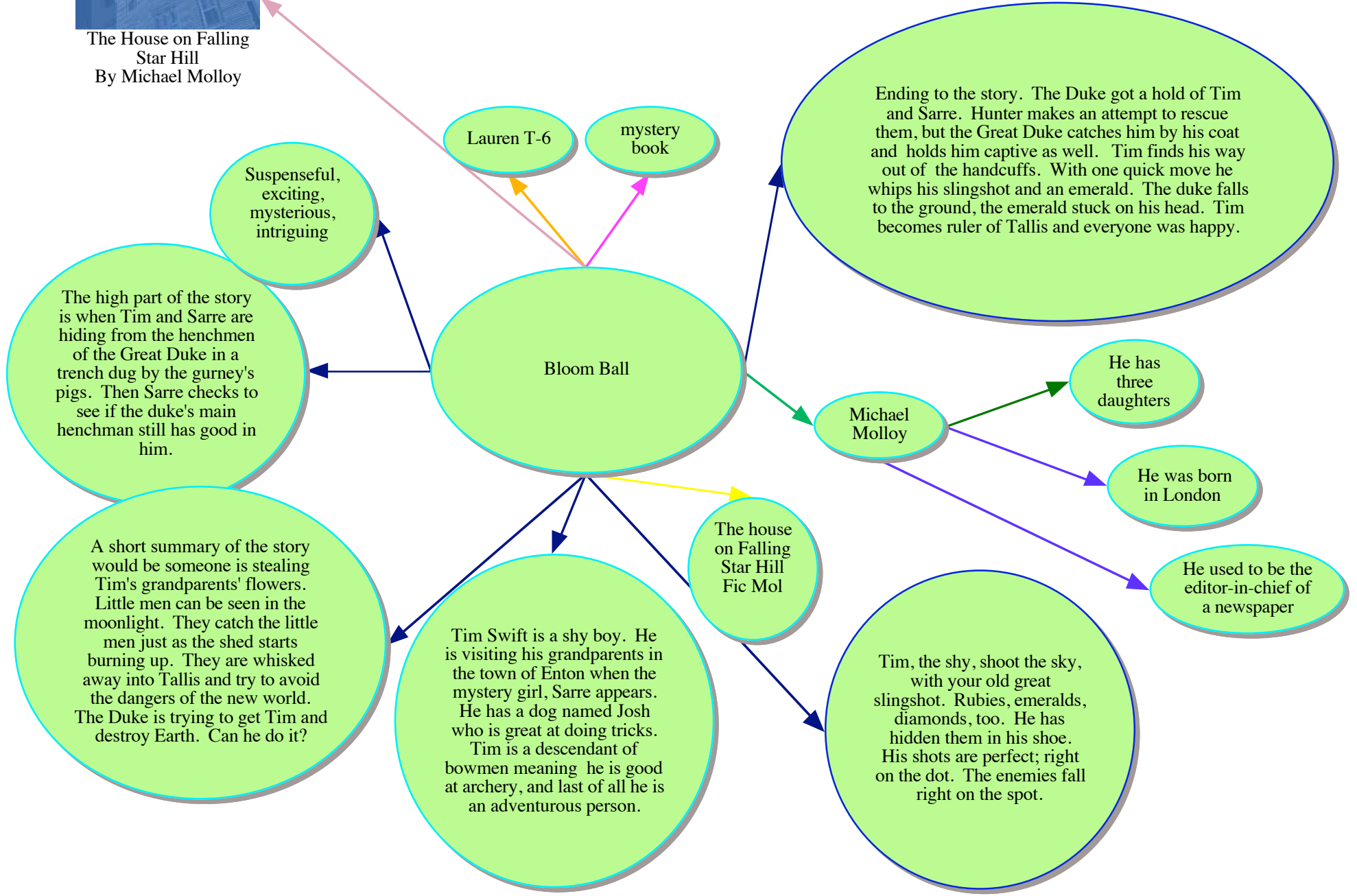




The House on Falling Star Hill
