<b>Lesson Title:</b>	Sandwich Book Report
<b>Grade Level/ Subject Area:</b>	4 <sup>th</sup> -5 <sup>th</sup> grade
<b>Performance Objectives:</b>	After completion of the lesson, students will be able to use <u>Inspiration</u> to organize information for a book report.

<b>Materials:</b>	Parts of Sandwich copied onto various colored paper, colored pencils, pencil, scissors, and Inspiration on laptops.
<b>Procedures:</b>	The class will read an AR book. After reading the book the class will organize the book report using <u>Inspiration</u> . The class will then put together their Sandwich report using the information from the <u>Inspiration</u> .
<b>Classroom Management:</b>	The class will have 3 weeks to read an AR book. After reading the book the class will organize their work by creating their work on Inspiration. After completing their graphic organizer in Inspiration they will print it off. From that they will create their Sandwich Reports by drawing and writing what is needed.
